The CCCA sees its social responsibility in providing and communicating scientifically sound contributions to combat challenges associated with climate change.

The CCCA sees itself as the focal point for all questions on the physical and societal basis of climate change, adaptation and mitigation.

- Support and networking of climate scientists in Austria (community building)
- Support and networking in national and international research activities
- Support of knowledge transfer within the network and externally
- Promotion of interdisciplinary and transdisciplinary discourses on climate research
- Promotion of young scientists
- Establishment and support of working groups on specific topics
- Organisation and implementation of scientific conferences, workshops and dialogue events.
- Development of assessment reports and other publications on climate change
- Support of its members in the transformation in the sense of UN 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development, for example through the exchange of information and experience
- Scientific advice to political and economic decision makers
